Referral Information (with additional information required under section 40(2)(a) of the Environmental Protection Act 1986).

The additional information is required for:

- the TSF and management of groundwater mounding;
- management of lead; and
- the proposed condition setting framework given this is a revised proposal.

Explanation of decision:

The studies conducted to date are adequate for inland waters environmental quality, terrestrial flora, and vegetation and fauna. The proponent has generally provided adequate referral information about the proposal, potential impacts, and proposed management measures to enable the EPA to undertake its assessment, however, additional information is required relating to air quality, terrestrial environmental quality and hydrological processes.
