(Include general description in the <a href="#">Instructions and template: How to identify the content of a proposal</a>)</b></p>	<p>The Wind Farm in Scott River Project is for the development of an onshore wind farm in the Scott River region, approximately 15 km north-east of the town of Augusta, in the South West of Western Australia.</p> <p>The Proposal will involve the construction and operation of up to 20 wind turbines, generating up to 100 MW, with associated infrastructure including monitoring and communication towers, operation and maintenance building, substation and transmission infrastructure and other supporting infrastructure. It is located across numerous freehold properties primarily cleared for agricultural purposes and Blue Gum plantation.</p> <p>The wind farm substation will connect the Proposal to the South West Interconnected System (SWIS) via the existing 132 kV Beenup to Manjimup transmission line.</p>
