Potential Significant Effects:	The Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) notes that the proposed 'Community Purpose' may require the expansion of existing onsite effluent disposal systems, which may result in potential local hydrological impacts to surface water and groundwater. Future development may also result in the clearing of native trees.		
Protection:	<p>The EPA notes that potential impacts to the above environmental values associated with implementation of the amendment are unlikely to be significant. Potential impacts can be managed by existing and proposed scheme text and future planning processes.</p> <p>The EPA expects future development to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be consistent with the requirements of the <i>Government Sewerage Policy 2019</i>, including preparation of a site and soil evaluation at the future planning stage, to inform the potential expansion of existing onsite effluent disposal, and • consider the retention of native trees.
